**Graduation Requirements**

- 60 credits for Associate of Applied Science (AAS).
- 2.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Proficiency requirement:** completion of ENG 20BCDE or place higher than ENG 20BCDE on the placement test & completion of MATH 20BCD or place higher than MATH 20BCD on the placement test. MATH 21 does not meet this requirement.
- Residency requirement:** The final twelve (12) credits in the major must be earned from HCC. This requirement may be waived. See an academic counselor for more information.
- When there is a break in enrollment for more than one year, you must use the graduation requirements in effect at the time of graduation.
- Submit graduation application by March 15 for Spring semester and by October 15 for Fall semester. There is no graduation in the summer.

**Special Instructions**

- Any person who has been accepted into the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard Apprenticeship Program is eligible for admission for the APTR-PH program at HCC.
- RELN 99 - 780 hours of approved PHNSY Trade Theory and General Experience Training required to earn 26 credits.
- WKPR 94V - 750 hours of work experience required to earn 10 credits.
