Graduation Requirements

- ❑ 62 credits for Associate of Applied Science Degree (AAS)
- ❑ 47 credits for Certificate of Achievement (CA)
- ❑ All COSM courses must be completed with a “C” or higher
- ❑ **Credits that don’t apply to degree:** Credits earned in MATH 20BCDEFG, ENG 20BCDE, ELI Courses, or ESL Courses do not fulfill program requirements.
- ❑ 2.0 cumulative grade point average
- ❑ **Proficiency requirement:** completion of ENG 20BCDE or place higher than ENG 20BCDE on the placement test & completion of MATH 20BCD or place higher than MATH 20BCD on the placement test. MATH 21 does not meet this requirement.
- ❑ **Residency requirement:** The final twelve (12) credits in the major must be earned at HCC. This requirement may be waived. See an academic counselor for more information.
- ❑ When there is a break in enrollment for more than one year, you must use the graduation requirements in effect at the time of graduation.
- ❑ Submit graduation application by March 15 for Spring semester and by October 15 for Fall semester. There is no graduation in the summer.

Special Instructions

1. Other courses recommended for Cosmetology are ART 30, FIRE 103, FT 111, PHIL 101. Please note that courses must be taken simultaneously with other COSM courses in order to get COSM clock hours. Highly recommended during the 3rd semester COSM courses. These courses have been pre-approved by the State of HI Board of Barbering and Cosmetology.
2. Students with fewer than 1800 clock hours have the option of registering for COSM 50V (variable 1-6 credits) to accumulate required hours during the Fourth Semester. Students must earn a “C” grade or higher. 3 credits of COSM 50V may be used towards the elective requirement.
3. Students who resume their *Beauty Culture Courses* after a lapse of Three (3) years or more cannot utilize previous earned hours
