Graduation Requirements

- ❑ **62-63 credits** for the Associate in Science (AS) degree, **16 credits** for the Certificate of Completion (CC), **9 credits** for the Certificate of Competence (CO).
- ❑ **2.0** cumulative grade point average (GPA)
- ❑ **“C”** or higher in all courses with an **“ED”** Alpha
- ❑ **Proficiency Requirements:**
 1. Students must have completed ENG 100
 2. Students must have completed MATH 50, 53 or 24 or placed into MATH 100 on the mathematics placement test.
- ❑ **Residency requirement:** The final twelve (12) credits in the major must be earned from HCC. This requirement may be waived. See an academic counselor for more information.
- ❑ When there is a break in enrollment for more than one year, you must use the graduation requirements in effect at the time of graduation.
- ❑ **Graduation Application:** Submit a Graduation Application Form by March 15th for the Spring semester and by October 15th for the Fall semester. There is no graduation in the summer.

Special Instructions

1. The **Associate in Science Degree (AS)** meets the Educational Requirements for a Preschool Teacher, Teacher-Director, or Director of a Private Preschool (1-2 years work experience also required).
2. The **Certificate of Completion (CC)** together with an AA, AS or AAS degree other than in Early Childhood Education meets the Educational Requirements for a Pre-School Teacher.
3. The **Certificate of Competence (CO)** and one additional 3 credits in a course with an ED alpha together with any BA or BS degree meets the Educational Requirements for a Pre-School Teacher. **NOTE:** With a Bachelors Degree in Elementary Education (B.Ed.) the Certificate of Competence (CO) meets the Educational Requirements for 6 credits beyond the B. Ed. for teachers in private early childhood programs license by the Department of Human Services (DHS).
4. **Child Development Associate (CDA):** ED 105, ED 110, and ED 131 meet the “Formal Training” requirements for the Child Development Associate (CDA) available through the Council for Early Childhood Recognition in Washington D.C. (www.cdacouncil.org).
5. **Bachelors Degree:** A Bachelors Degree from University of Hawaii at West Oahu through the Department of Social Sciences is currently being developed and submitted for approval. Students who enter the Early Childhood Education program in the Fall of 2006 are projected to be able to transition to the Bachelors Degree program at UH West Oahu upon completion of the Associate in Science Degree (AS) in Early Childhood Education.
