### Graduation Requirements

- 60 credits for Associate of Applied Science Degree (AAS).
- 30-31 credits for Certificate of Achievement (CA).
- 2.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Proficiency requirement:** completion of ENG 20BCDE or place higher than ENG 20BCDE on the placement test & completion of MATH 20bcd or place higher then MATH 20BCD on the placement test. MATH 21 does not meet this requirement.
- Residency requirement:** The final twelve (12) credits in the major must be earned at HCC. This requirement may be waived. See an academic counselor for more information.
- Submit graduation application by March 15 for Spring semester and by October 15 for Fall semester. There is no graduation in the summer.
- When there is a break in enrollment for more than one year, you must use the graduation requirements in effect at the time of graduation.
- \*Elective credits that don't count:** Credits earned in MATH 20BCDEFG, ENG 20BCDE, ELI Courses, or ESL Courses may not be used to fulfill requirements.
